Nude 2010 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Habitat Valencia is launching **nude** 2010. The show is at once an exhibition and an opportunity for young international designers to meet professionals from the interiors industry (manufacturers and distributors) and society in general.

nude 2010 will be a fresh canvas that will reveal, through the eyes of the new designers, the latest trends and innovations that are emerging in the world of interiors.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR TAKING PART

The **nude** 2010 show aspires to be a gateway for new designers to enter the interiors industry. Participation is therefore open to students, young international designers and creatives and to Design Schools. It is also open to manufacturers that have been in business for under five years and to galleries that show designs that reflect the spirit and terms of this Show.

Submission and selection of designs

As regards the items themselves, all objects and pieces of equipment designed for interiors are acceptable.

The graphic material relating to the objects and their physical presence on the stand must be submitted for each design.

This material will consist of a detailed description on A3 size art board, which should be presented in a standard A3 file. The file must be properly identified, with the applicant's details and indicating the number of documents contained in the file. It should also include a CD with jpg's of the products.

Participants should complete a registration form (see the Habitat website, www.feriavalencia.com/habitat) which should be delivered along with the rest of the design.

Designs should arrive between 10th and 20th May 2010 (both dates inclusive) and should be sent to the following address:

The Selection Committee will announce which pieces of work will be displayed at this ninth edition of the **nude** Show.

Applicants selected to exhibit their work at the **nude** Show will be required to make a payment of 800 euros + 7% VAT to cover the rental of a pre-decorated stand. This payment must be made by 1st September 2010.

Exhibition of work.

As regards the exhibition, the **nude** Show organisers will provide information on the technical specifications of the display space and which areas of the space the designer concerned will be able to decorate and what form of decoration will be permitted.

The Selection Committee.

The Selection Committee will be tasked with assessing which designs present features that best embody the spirit of the **nude** Show. The Committee will also verify compliance with the terms and conditions governing participating in the Show.

The Selection Committee, or a part of the Committee delegated to do so, will check that each design accepted does indeed comply with the terms and may refuse to allow a piece of work to be displayed if there is a clear divergence between the design that was approved and the object that is put on display.

The Committee's decisions will be final and the Committee will have the authority to make any decisions that should need to be made during the selection process and subsequent exhibition.

Publicity.

The Organisers will publish leaflets, press releases, a nude blog, electronic newsletters and news on the **nude** 2010 website, to which end they will request that exhibitors provide such graphic material as they may consider necessary.
